



pledge to create and save nature. This event was co-ordinated by Mr. A.Chockalingam, Assistant Professor, and Department of Information Technology.








◆ On August 13, 2024, the Anti-Drug committee successfully conducted the 'Pledge Against Anti-Drug' event at 10:30 a.m. The







from Dr. Mariammal, Head of the Department of B.Com PA and CS. The day was a joyful celebration for all the teachers.




