1. Teaching and Learning Enhancement

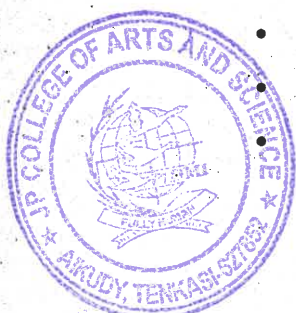
- Integration of ICT tools and Learning Management Systems (LMS)
