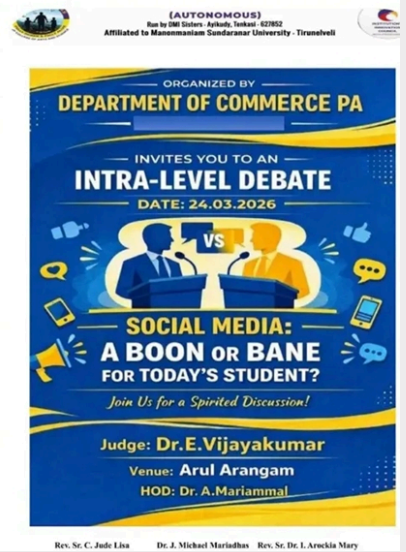
Ethics and Communication in Modern Business Environment



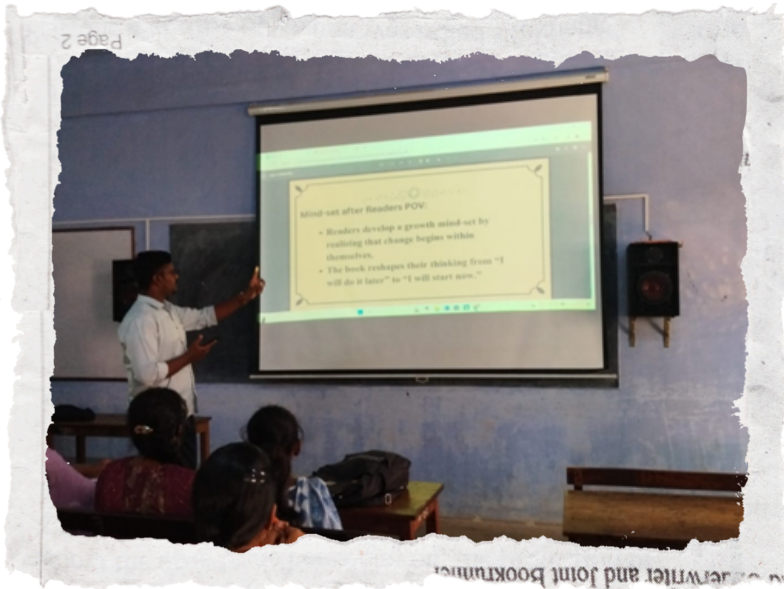
