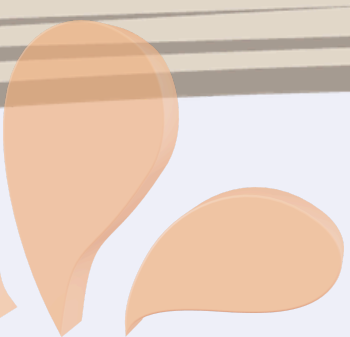

To our faculty and parents, thank you for being strong partners in shaping young minds with skill, values, and purpose.

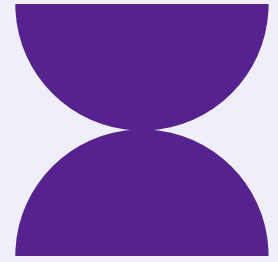

MOU SIGNING CEREMONY

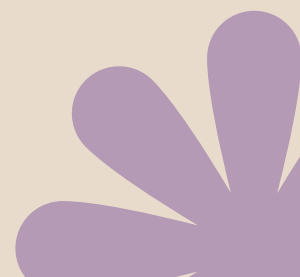
